Objectives

Bringing academia and industry together

Primary

- Improve knowledge exchange between industry and academia
- 50 ECRs (PhDs and Postdocs) from SCCS partners to present results to industry/business/regulators annually
- Receive industry *feedback*

Secondary

- Funding of PhD studentships for specific projects
- Receive regular industry steer



Outcomes

Bringing academia and industry together

- Better informed research (by industrial needs)
- Better integrated research (across CCS chain & related areas, across Scottish universities)
- Uptake of research findings and application by industry
- Development of new industry focused research and training activities
- Development of industry funding streams
- ECRs better prepared to work in CCS/carbon management industry
- Improved recruitment for ECRs into CCS/carbon management industry
- Improve expertise & employability of industry personnel
